



2012 Town of Duck Fourth of July Parade Participation Guidelines & Policies



Duck 4th of July
Parade Information

1. All entries participate at the sole discretion of the Town of Duck Parade Committee.
2. By entering the parade staging areas, each entrant and participant agrees to hold the Town of Duck Parade Committee and the Town of Duck harmless for any injury, damage to personal property, or other personal damages.
3. Once you enter the parade line-up, there is to be **ABSOLUTELY NO STOPPING** for any reason.
4. **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED** for all riders of bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, scooters (motorized or not), motorcycles, etc., **REGARDLESS OF YOUR AGE**. In addition, all laws related to helmet use will be enforced by the Duck Police Department. Violators are subject to disqualification from the Parade.
5. Entries that are deemed inappropriate by the Parade Committee are subject to disqualification and/or ejection from the Parade.
6. No consumption of alcohol or any controlled substance without a legitimate prescription in any Parade area (including but not limited to Pre-Parade and Post-Parade areas) and during the Parade (commencing with the opening of Parade registration) is permitted.
7. Entrants may not double-back along the Parade route while the Parade is in progress.
8. All participants will exit Christopher Drive and make a right turn onto NC12/Duck Road going northward. To ensure entrant and spectator safety, there **WILL NOT BE ANY** left turns permitted at the end of Christopher Drive.
