

Recycle Center

Please follow these instructions and those of the site attendants. Some disposal restrictions are noted.

Please separate and prepare your materials as directed and place them in the recycling containers. Thanks You!

Glass: brown, green, clear, bottles and jars. Porcelain, ceramic, plates, mirrors, windows (glass only), crystal, bake ware. No light bulbs, or window frames!

Preparation: rinse, remove lids. No need to separate colors.

Plastics: #1 bottles soda, water and juice. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastic. NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM or Motor oil bottles.

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Plastics: #2 bottles and jugs, translucent milk, water and tea jugs. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastics. NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM of any kind, buckets, or toys.

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Plastics: #2 - #7 bottles and jugs, colored Laundry soap containers, toiletries containers, etc. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastics. NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM of any kind.

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Batteries: Lead-acid automotive, marine, mower and all other vehicle and rechargeable batteries, and single use battery.

Paper Bin: Newspaper, copy paper, mail, food boxes, shoeboxes, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper bags. No plastic bags, paper that is wet, contaminated with food or dirt such as pizza boxes!!!!

Cardboard bin: Corrugated cardboard only. Must be dry, flattened and all packing materials must be removed. No waxed, wet or dirty boxes allowed. No styrofoam.

Used motor oil: From Residential sources only. Don't forget to bring your used oil filter! Maximum 5 gallons per visit. NO mixtures of motor oil and water, solvents, gasoline, paint products, flammable liquids, brake fluid or any other hazardous materials.

Cooking Oil: From Residential sources only.

Anti_Freeze/Coolant: From Residential sources only.

Aluminum cans: beverage only, no pet food cans. Place in bin marked aluminum cans. Crushing is optional.

Steel cans: including pet food cans. Must be rinsed, label may stay on and placed into steel cans bin.

Scrap metals and appliances: stoves, washers, water heaters, air conditioners, refrigerators, pipe, siding, tools, lawn mowers, etc. NO, auto gas tanks or oil reservoirs. DO NOT crush appliances that contain Freon; drain all fluid reservoirs and tanks.

Waste Gasoline and 2-cycle gas from residential sources only. Maximum 5 gallons per visit. Do not place in oil tanks. Please see attendant for assistance.

Electronics: All electronic devices and computer monitors.

Small Propane Tanks the ones typically used with outdoor grills. NO large household heating tanks. **PLEASE CALL THE GAS COMPANY LISTED ON THE TANK FOR LARGE TANKS.**

Bulky items, construction and demolition debris **FROM KITTY HAWK RESIDENTS ONLY.** Furniture, lumber, siding, junk, glass, carpet, TV's, etc. **No mattresses, box springs, hot tubs or hot tub covers!**

Pallets: 3 per visit

Shingles: NONE

Concrete/Asphalt/Brick: 1 wheelbarrow load per month!

NO commercially generated C & D or bulky waste items. These must be taken to the Dare County C & D landfill.

Tires: Tires must be off the rim. From Residential sources only. Maximum 4 tires per visit.

Shells: Oysters, clams, and mussels. Place in yellow bin marked as such.

Brush, leaves, and lawn clippings: lawn clippings, leaves, or brush. Lawn clippings and brush must be disposed at the Dare County Public Works facility located at 1018 Driftwood Drive, in Manteo.

Many thrift shops in Dare County will accept gently used household items or clothes. Please call them for details.
