

HOW WE GOT HERE

- EROSION AND SHORELINE MANAGEMENT FEASIBILITY STUDY COMPLETED IN MAY 2013
 - RECOMMENDED AN OFFSHORE DREDGE PROJECT TO MITIGATE STORM DAMAGE AND EROSION IN SEGMENTS 7 & 8 OF THE STUDY (AN AREA NORTH OF THE ACOE FRF PROPERTY TO MARTIN LANE)
- THE TOWN CONTRACTED WITH CP&E FOR PERMITTING AND ENGINEERING FOR THE PROJECT
 - AS A RESULTS OF FURTHER ENGINEERING THE PROJECT AREA WAS REDUCED FROM ALL OF SEGMENT 7 & 8 TO ALL OF SEGMENT 7 AND A PORTION OF SEGMENT 8 (AN AREA NORTH OF THE ACOE FRF PROPERTY TO JUST NORTH OF OYSTER CATCHER LANE) APPROVED BY COUNCIL ON NOVEMBER 5, 2014







- PUBLIC HEARING IS ON THE PROPOSED MSD-A AND MSD-B AND THE COUNCIL APPROVED 20-40-40 PLAN AS THE PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE
- AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING, COUNCIL MAY ADOPT A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MSDS AND PAYMENT PLAN AS PRESENTED OR ADJUST ONE OR BOTH
- RATES ESTABLISHED BY THE MSDS WILL GO INTO EFFECT JULY 1, 2015







